Colossians 1:24-29

- **24** I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church,
- **25** of which I became a minister according to the stewardship from God which was given to me for you, to fulfill the word of God,
- **26** the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints.

- **27** To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
- **28** Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus.
- **29** To this end I also labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily. NKJV

2 Tim 1:8-12

- **8** Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God,
- **9** who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,
- **10** but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,

- **11** to which I was appointed a preacher, an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.
- **12** For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day. NKJV
